I encourage you to make a prayer space in your home if you don't have one already. You can use things you already have. It can be elaborate...but it can just as easily be very simple: a Bible, rosary, cross and candle. This physical place holder can remind your kids (and you!) of God's presence in your home during this time of social distancing. It sends a strong message that God is important and that we are in His care.



Pray together as a family. This will bring your family together and bring the Light of Christ noticeably into your home. While your kids may complain at first, this structure can be a meaningful way to reconnect with the Lord as a family. Pray for your family, medial workers, the vulnerable, the ill, and the whole world!

There are thousands of ways to pray and you can definitely find one (or more) that work for your family and kids at the ages of yours. You can lead them yourself – or use a video or recording if you are uncomfortable leading- either way, I really encourage you to add a consistent prayer structure into your day. Consider:

- -The Rosary
- The Divine Mercy Chaplet
- Reading from the Bible and talking about it
- Stations of the Cross
- Liturgy of the Hours
- Five minutes (or more, or less) of total silence in the house with no screens where everyone prays/ journals spiritually.
- Singing Christian music as a family (with or without a recording)
- Sharing 1 thing each family members is grateful for and thanking God
- Spiritual reading

- Religious coloring pages (yes, the internet has that!)
